LUC: Rita mtg this month, last month 3/27 was Ken Tarr's last mtg, he thanked for the use of the Rec Center, they haven't had a good LUC mtg in the last 3-4 months due to conflicts, Kate is new to LUC and excited to help with all positive work for the community, Rita will be doing the handbook over, thinking of getting a secretary also to help with notes, mtg's etc. LUC wants to help parks with either landscaping or painting the skate park, they will talk with Marty about what they can do to help.

PARKS DIRECTOR: Marty said that things are very busy with IRP playground, demo starting 4/12/23, equipment arrived on 4/10/23. Turf mtg on Thursday 4/13/23 to finalize stripped colors on the field. June 21st they can come to start, it should take 5 weeks & the whole area will be closed due to the construction, also notified the NRPD to be able to patrol. The bids for Tennis courts & Basketball courts have to be re-done and updated, they should get done in the late Spring. Waiting on the state grants for the B-ball court, hockey rink & Kids Spot that has to be used by June 30, 2023, the town engineer has been great in helping out onsite.

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Marty got an email from player/instructor of Pickleball unhappy with the lack of pickleball facilities in town. Conversation was had as to how we should respond. Marty as department head will respond notifying him of our long term plans to put pickleball courts in town. MT informed the committee that he has his seasonal guys hopefully starting next month.

<u>OPERATIONS DIRECTOR:</u> Maria said our balance sheet profit of \$46K. The department is busy and doing well with registrations and permits. SC asked what are little league #'s are as he heard they have gone down, but MB said she hasn't gotten the #'s yet, should receive them by the end of April beginning of May & will report it at next mtg.

RECREATION DIRECTOR: Nancy stated doing fantastic, #'s are great, Ashley does a fantastic job, our longtime pickleball instructor has departed from teaching and Ashley has found us another instructor Mike Messier that will start in May, we have a few clinics/programs over April vacation and more Spring programs coming. We have 2 returning counselors so far for Summerscape and we have several interviews set up. At this time we currently have 56 children signed up for Summerscape.

FONRPR: Discussed BBQ, we have all the bands, entertainers and sponsorships done thanks to Heidi for coordinating them. Maureen will be sending out a list of all the things she has done for the BBQ and have everyone volunteer their time and pick what they will help out with. Sergio gave a nice ice cream cart on wheels to have for the BBQ's. Heidi will create a sign up for High School Volunteers on Sign up Genius.

<u>Intergeneration Center:</u> Maria distributed a draft of the intergenerational community center staff needs to be reviewed by rec committee & further discussion will be held on the next rec mtg.
