1. **Visit with Dr. Daly** – Dr. Patrick Daly spoke about PAUSE and health/wellness. He said there is a focus to address the “whole” child, bullying response, and prevention plans. The team also works on LGBTQ safety and needs. His wellness group is required to meet at least 4 times per year. This year he combined the PAUSE and wellness groups with himself and the new Director of PPS. His team is looking into an overall town-wide health and wellness including food services. Food services just recently updated their website with info on menus, calorie counts, and is targeted for both parents and students to use.
