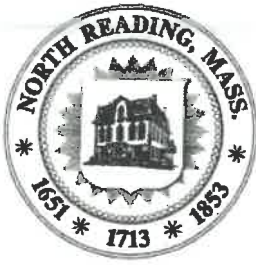

New Business:

Order Restricting the Number of Persons in Essential Establishments

The Health Department is expanding on the Emergency Declaration, amending to add this section. The Order to Restrict the number of Persons in Essential Business Establishments was distributed to the Board for review. This Order will help to ensure social distancing, remaining six (6) feet apart while in essential businesses. As well as posting an employee at the door to ensure that the Establishment stays within the amount of persons allowed in the establishment. The following revisions will be made to the document

Under item 10 Stores are to mark one way aisles to be labeled with customer traffic flow pattern for each aisle. The store shall also post a label/sign that shall read "please follow recommended customer traffic flow pattern."

Under item 12 The Board of Health is recommending that all essential establishment employees wear personal protective equipment (PPE) i.e. a face covering for the mouth and nose.

Gary Hunt Motioned to accept the Order contingent upon the revision and review of the document.



All members voted unanimously in favor.


