## PURPOSE OF MEETING: To Discuss FY2022 Budget to present to Finance and TA.

MS presented FY2022 Budget to the Parks & Recreation Committee.

MS explained that it was a difficult budget to work on due to the Covid conditions/restrictions. MS went over line items in Budget. MS also made note that the budget could change either way (positive/negative) depending on if the conditions/restrictions change.

## Some things mentioned:

If we were to open IRP concession we would only sell packaged foods. We would only hire one person and most likely breakeven.

Parks: we usually hire three seasonal. Not sure if Finance/TA will agree. No seasonal OT.

When MS meets with Finance/TA she will be asking for Parks position salary (\$56,961) to be paid for under

DPW. She explained how: Expenses: \$666,334

Revenues: \$609,372

\$56,962 difference of \$1 to DPW Position: \$56,961

If Town agrees to this transfer, Parks & Recreation would breakeven. MS will be asking Town to pay DPW position and Operations Director End of Career Buyback. All in favor of budget proposals.
