## MS. Operations Director Update:

MS – reviewed the FY2021 Spreadsheet as of 4/30/21. Profit as of 4/30/21 was \$18,000. This month, 5/31/21 our profit is at \$90,000, 48% increase in revenue. Spring revenue starts July 1st. Last year we had very little programs running. This year we are bringing in money running lots of programs.

MS has informed the Parks Director to begin shopping for a mower and that we will look into hiring a second seasonal employee.

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MS – we will not need most of the money Recreation Director asked for from FONRPPR. We received sponsorships for the SummerScape Children's Entertainers.

We will be in a better place with the FY22 Budget.

5/18 – \$500,000 Grant Request. There was a meeting with State employees (EOEEA) that including the Danielle McKnight in Planning, P&R, TA, Brad Jones. This Grant request has been since 2018. Meeting went well.

State was impressed with our parks.

We've cancelled the entertainers for the BBQ, but we are now using most for Recreation Director's SummerScape program. Since they are not funning Field Trips they will be bringing in these children entertainers on Wednesday's. Bands are disappointed but maybe if we add a couple of BBQ's in July we can use some. RK mentioned that COVID restrictions will be lifted, can we discuss dates to possibly offer some BBQ's. MS – restrictions are lifted, will need to discuss food with BOH. RM spoke to BOH, he mentioned no restrictions with food. Discussion was had with choosing two dates, July 14, 21 or 28. Determined that July 21 and 28 works best for all committee members. SS mentioned possibly sending a letter to Pipefitters for sponsorship donation. It was determined that we should have a separate BBQ meeting to discuss the BBQ with FONRPR. We will have a separate meeting on June 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:45pm.
