Parks Director: Update Continued.

- Rich Giannattasio has given them an estimate of expenses for the security cameras at the park. He's broken it up into Bandstand/Shed area - \$2,570, Snack Shack (update current camera) - \$1,380 and Skate Park - \$3,200. Chief Murphy and RM have stressed the necessity of having a camera at the Skate Park. Need to drill trenches behind the Snack Shack. Camera will be on Pole, where you will be able to see the Skate Park and open field. MT – need to get additional quotes to be in compliance. RM asked if we receive a reduction in our insurance if we have the cameras. MS will ask the TA's office. The expense of the Security Camera's is a Small Capital Item. RM asked if there was any other area/park that would benefit from having a security camera. MT stated that we are fortunate that he did not feel any other area/park would need a camera.
