NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

To: Haverhill Street & Park Street Residents

From: Town of North Reading Department of Public Works

UPDATE - The Department of Public Works will begin repaving the following sections of road on or soon after October 9, 2018.

- Haverhill Street – From North Street to the Andover Town Line
- Park Street – From Main Street (Rte 28) to the Wilmington Town Line

This work will be done in a two part process:

Part I – Hot In-Place Recycling – The contractor performing this work is Highway Rehab. Corp. of Brewster, NY. This work will begin on or after October 9, 2018 and will last approximately 5 working days. The Park Street section is currently scheduled to be completed first. Work times are Monday to Saturday 7am to 7pm. A heating and grinding process will be used to recycle the existing road which creates a new road base.

Part II – Paving – The contractor performing this work is EJ Paving of Methuen MA. This work will begin approximately two weeks after Part I and will last 3-4 days. The contractor will pave a new top surface on the road.

Residents can expect altered traffic patterns and delays during these operations. Emergency vehicles and school buses will be allowed passage and a police officer will be present. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
