Update on FY24 One-Time Funding

June 2023 Town Meeting, Warrant Article 33

\$60,000 one-time funding for pilot and assessment efforts by Transportation Committee and Commission on Disability

To date:

- \$1,654 for Accessibility Survey. Mailed in January, results pending.
- \$3,318 for volunteer software, vehicle rentals, backup ride service, volunteer lunch July 2023 to February 2024.
- \$780 for driver and coordinator hours

Future use:

- \$37,000 was proposed as match for \$88,000 in MassDOT grants. MassDOT will require only \$17,000 match, allowing the other \$20,000 to be used more flexibly.
- Warrant Article Funding should last through June 2025 or later
