Mission

FORMATION

The North Reading Wastewater Project Committee will be formed to educate the townspeople about the proposed wastewater project that would provide a wastewater utility for Main Street and Concord Street, and portions of Lowell Road, North Street, and Park Street. Establishing public wastewater service is essential to the town's long-term public health, public safety, economic growth and quality of life. The Wastewater Project Committee membership shall consist of a combination of representatives from various elected and appointed boards, committees, and employees of the Town of North Reading and a cross-section of North Reading citizens of diverse interests. The membership shall be appointed by the Select Board, who shall make changes in the membership, as necessary.

FUNCTION

The primary function of the North Reading Wastewater Project Committee will be to educate the townspeople about the proposed wastewater project, including the project need and geographic area, the cost to taxpayers, the cost to connect to the system, and the benefits to abutters and to the Town as a whole. The Wastewater Project Committee will achieve this by hosting public information sessions, distributing information to the townspeople, and answering questions from the townspeople.

COMPLETION

The North Reading Wastewater Project Committee will continue to serve through fall 2023 Town Meeting and, if necessary, a Town election on the Main Street / Concord Street wastewater project.
