## **Agenda Issues Discussed in Priority Order:**

- 1. Gather all available maps of land owned by the Town of North Reading that would fall under the purview of the Forest Committee
  - a. Reach out to Danielle McKnight and Abby Hurlburt as possible sources
- 2. Locate money from the first two steps of the Swan Pond cutting program (Karen Marlin)
  - a. Verify the amount
  - b. Identify process for using money to buy new forestry equipment in the future
- 3. Look into step 3 of the Swan Pond cutting program
  - a. Reach out to forester (John Roberts)
  - b. Compile all paperwork regarding the cutting program (Karen Marlin)
  - c. Get approval to move ahead with step 3 cutting
- 4. Develop Forest Committee master plan
  - a. Trail survey program
    - i. Identify all trails under the purview of the Forest Committee
    - ii. Name all trails
    - iii. Commission signs for trail (reach out to Eagle Scouts?)
  - b. Trail maintenance programs
    - i. Design overview of volunteer-led trail maintenance program
      - 1. Reach out to Avis and AMC for more ideas/suggestions
    - ii. Request copy of waiver used by Andover town volunteer programs
    - iii. Procure equipment for trail maintenance from previous funds AND/OR solicit new funding for equipment
    - iv. Write-up detailed program summary and request for volunteer-overseers
    - v. Divide trail areas into sections for different volunteer-overseers
    - vi. Identify potential volunteer-overseers (*Girl/Boy scouts, corporations such as Amazon in North Reading, etc.*) who may be willing to do routine, or yearly (*Earth Day?*) trail maintenance projects
    - vii. Reach out on local & social media to recruit volunteers who may be interested in occasional community service opportunities
    - viii. Set up mailing list using new Forest Committee email to keep local volunteers informed of trail maintenance community service opportunities
  - c. Address Swan Pond safety & accessibility issues
    - i. Find working keys for access gates at Swan Pond
    - ii. Speak to DPW (John Parisi) regarding the following:

- 1. Changing the access and parking area for Swan Pond trails
- 2. Moving boulders to block unauthorized motor vehicles from accessing trails in the Swan Pond area
- iii. Speak to Select board regarding the following:
  - 1. Possible new by-law to prohibit unauthorized use of motor vehicles on town, school, and conservation land (*Note that motorized wheelchairs would be considered authorized vehicles*)
  - 2. Request for hunting permission and/or registration information on town land
- 5. Reviewed information received from Robert Douglas, Director of Conservation in Andover about their trail maintenance efforts
  - a. Will write one-page summary of Andover programs' information
  - b. Will request copy of the waiver they use for volunteer-led efforts
- 6. Reviewed Forest Committee webpage updates
- 7. Voted to approve previous meeting minutes
- 8. Scheduled next meeting
