The Senior Center offers backup coverage for volunteers.

# Regional/Public Providers

Medi MeVa (Merrimack Valley Transit) provides free rides to medical appointments at Lahey Peabody or Boston hospitals Mondays, Tuesdays or Thursdays; or Bedford VA Wednesdays and Fridays. # Additional Special Services

Ask your doctor, hospital or insurance company for transportation options based on your medical needs. **PACE, SCO, ACO, and some Medicare Advantage plans** cover rides. Ask the Senior Center about SHINE Medicare Counseling if you'd like to see these options.

If you receive state or federal benefits or participate in social service programs, ask program staff for transportation options or subsidies. (All decisions about eligibility rest with the agencies.)
