Chair Peter Majane called the meeting to order at 6:02 pm.

- 1. Welcome Assistant Superintendent Sean Killeen. Chair Peter Majane welcomed Sean Killeen, Assistant Superintendent, North Reading Public Schools. Mr. Killeen shared a presentation "Getting Better Everyday" and P.A.U.S.E (Public Awareness & Understanding of Social Education) Update. The three areas of focus for the school year 2020-2021 are: Health & Wellness Self Care, Social Justice & Equity, and Social & Emotional Learning. - **5. Social Services Report:** YS Director Jen Ford continues to have a lot of conversations on socialization and mental health. We need to continue to support each other. Real life struggles are still happening along with COVID. YS Director Jen Ford and member Amy DiChiara shared their experience helping with COVID vaccination clinics greeting and talking with seniors.
- **6. Old Business:** No old business was discussed.
- **7. New Business**: YS Director Jen Ford shared the Virtual Reality Fair documents with the committee prior to the meeting. It will be given to the high school to share with Seniors and Juniors. Committee members provided comments and had a discussion on its content and how to encourage participation.
